Over the past year, the Open Centre has been working hard to **improve the services** it provides to its visitors. This has resulted in; an increase in bookings, new staff members, new

From September 2015 to July 2016 the Open Centre noted a new record for visitors to the centre with an extra 2237 visitors, compared to the previous year. Through the increase in visitors, the Open Centre has been able to promote diversity and community cohesion within the local area, along with helping schools



to make donations to the local community via the Open Centre. Last year the Open Centre



was able to **donate an extra £2420** to the local community and support local projects. We have already had a wealth of bookings for this next year so we are anticipating an even **greater number** of visitors.

Even we are still learning...


